### LEED™ CREDIT POINTS, REFERENCE & POTENTIAL

*This credit point is available only if the TrendWall to be used in this project was previously installed elsewhere, then is reused in your project. Such reused TrendWall (with any other reused materials) must equal at least 30% of the total F&F budget.*
